A fifteen minute drive from the sleepy village of Larva through rolling countryside takes you to this little hamlet based around the mansion. The main property was built by the owners father in the early 1900's and it's antebellum architecture makes us wonder if the gentleman had visited the deep South because this is a true plantation house in the middle of Jaen. There is the main house, a very large cortijo 300 m² in ruins, 12 enormous workshops/stables/warehouses, 26 cave houses to reform and a folly!! In its hey day the estate provided work for over 700 staff. The main house in itself is stunning although in need of external re-decoration. The ground floor has been used for storage but provides five large rooms. The first floor is immaculate and you feel that you have stepped back in time to the 1950's. There is a reception room and opposite that is the old scullery with a double stone sink and open fireplace. The period furniture, bric a brac, paintings, everywhere you look there is reference to that time and it's all included in the sale. The third is a bedroom and fourth would be a good room to divide into a utility area and bathroom. The fifth could be another...
